

RESOLUTIONS OF GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

Subject : Incorporation to the limits of granted scale to Sri Manjunathaswamy First Grade College and its teaching Staff which is being run by SC/STs under the management of Sri Manjunathaswamy Vidya Samsthe @ - reg.

PREAMBLE :

As per the Karnataka Educational Institutions (Collegiate Education) Rules 2003. framed under Government Notification read above (1), there is no provision to incorporate any of the private Degree Colleges and subjects into the limits of grant-in-aid which started after 1.6.1987.

The Government has decided and resolved in cabinet meeting which was held on 18.02.2009 that the SC/ST Managing Committees which are running Colleges and conducting courses between 1.6.1987 to 31.3.1995 to be incorporated to grant-in-aid.

An opportunity has been given to the First Grade Colleges which are started between 1.6.1987 to 31.3.1995 and being run under the management of SC/STs to incorporate them into grant-in-aid by amending in notification No. (2) dt. 13.5.2009 above by adding to the Rule 8 of the above, only in respect of private First Grade Colleges which are being run by SC/ST managements. The Government has passed the Order to incorporate the First Grade colleges which are being run by the SC/ST managements and which are started between 1.6.1987 to 31.3.1995 to incorporate into grant-in-aid, by prescribing certain conditions read with (3) dt. 5.10.2009 above. The Commissioner of Collegiate Education has furnished the proposal to Government by perusing that to which of teaching and non teaching staffs are to be incorporated into grant-in-aid under Ref(4) read above dt. 5.10.2010. A requisition was made to Finance Department to incorporate the above

college and the eligible Lecturers who are working in it for grant-in-aid. Regarding the incorporation of 5 colleges into the limits of grant-in-aid, the conditions already levied on it and in addition to it by levying a few more conditions, and if it is fulfilled, incorporation of grant-in-aid would be done as second phase. But the colleges which are incorporated to grant-in-aid at first phase, the conditions which were not levied earlier were levied. A requisition was made to the Government not to levy the additional conditions but to exempt them from being levied; accordingly, the Government relaxed the additional conditions as per the Ref (5) read above; and further it accorded permission to the above said college as well as other 9 colleges, also permitted to eligible Lecturers who are working in them to bring into grant-in-aid. Accordingly, the Government has resolved that by scrutinizing the proposals proposed by the Collegiate Education Directorate regarding qualification of candidates, duty hours and reservation, the above said college and the eligible Lecturers who are working in it for the subjects shown against them are to be incorporated into the limit of grant-in-aid with effect from the date of passing this Order.

Hence this Order.

**GOVERNMENT ORDER NO.ED 169 UPC 2010 BANGALORE,
DT.11.11.2011**

Under the Circumstances of the facts narrated in the Preamble the educational institution which is being run and started under the SC/ST managements between 1.6.1987 to 31.3.1995, Sri. Manjunathaswamy First Grade College of Sri. Manjunathaswamy Vidya Samsthe @ Davangere has been brought under the grant-in-aid with financial facility from the date of this Order.

The above said college and the subject wise faculties who are performing duty for the subjects shown against them and the posts/subjects have been brought under grant-in-aid code and subject to the conditions shown below:-

1. If it is found any incapability in any of the faculties who are incorporated in grant-in-aid under this Order, such grant-in-aid would be withdrawn without any prior notice.
2. It is subject to the condition that if any variation is found in reservation of appointment, grant-in-aid of such person would be withdrawn.
3. The pay scale of the above said faculties who are incorporated into the limits of grant-in-aid should be fixed under the minimum pay scale extended from the date of Order.
4. The person who is appointed before 11.7.2009 and if they obtained M.phil it is being continued to give UGC pay scale. But in this case, many of the faculties / Lecturers passed through in the examinations which was held earlier to 11.7.2009, concerned Universities have issued their Certificates after 11.7.2009; under this circumstance, it is being clarified with the Finance Department in respect of extending the UGC scale which date should be considered either date of examination or date of issuance of Certificate. Hence, subject to the conditions of granting prescribed State pay scale by withdrawing the UGC pay scale – when the Government would come to conclusion to consider the date of issuance of Certificate to the Lecturers who are brought into grant-in-aid limits.


5. It is subject to the condition that if any deficiency in respect of duty hours of Lecturers who were brought under grant-in-aid they might be deputed to the granted colleges/Government colleges where the duty of such Lecturers would be necessary.
6. As mentioned in the Bye-law, all the Board of Directors must be of SC/ST. In case it is appointed a person of different community, it is subjected to the condition of withdrawing the grant-in-aid.
7. As stated in Rule 15(E) Appendix (2) of Karnataka Educational Institutions (Collegiate Education) Rules, 2003, the institution should provide the basic amenities including Lecture Halls, Laboratories, Toilets etc.
8. At the time of enlisting the colleges into grant-in-aid, the colleges which are being run by the SC/STs, the strength of the SC/ST students must be minimum 35%. At the time of admission at least minimum strength of students must be maintained. Unless it is subjected to the condition of withdrawing the grant-in-aid.
9. These colleges should enroll a minimum as prescribed by the Universities and in such enrolment; the colleges should see that at least 75% of students should appear for examinations, unless it is subjected to the condition of withdrawing the grant-in-aid.
10. The result of these colleges should not be less than the other recognized colleges of concerned Universities, unless it is subjected to the condition of withdrawing the grant-in-aid.
11. The colleges which have been started after obtaining the recognition from competent authority should be run the colleges without any interruption. In case of any interruption, it is subjected to the condition of withdrawing the grant-in-aid.
12. Appointments should be made under the provisions of Karnataka Educational Institutions (Collegiate Education), Rules 2003 and such other provisions. A minimum strength of students in each and every class should be maintained. In respect of Degree Classes, in every class at least 40 students of attendance is compulsory. In the subject of languages minimum number of students must be 10, and in optional subjects a minimum number of students must be 15.
13. Apart from requisite amenities, own building and play ground must be possessed. The institutions which have not possess these amenities, they should equip within 3 years from the date of incorporation of grant-in-aid, and even after 3 years if these amenities are not equipped, grant-in-aid would be withheld.


4. Without prior permission of competent authority vacancies should not be filled in future.
5. In respect of direct appointment, promotion and admission of students, Government Orders/Rulings must be followed time to time.
6. While filling up the vacancies created out of resignation, superannuation, death; prior permission of Government should be obtained and reservation policy of Government should be followed.
7. It must be sure that before releasing the grant-in-aid to the granted posts, as per the Government and UGC Rules age/ qualification and such other conditions.
8. The expenses for the salary fro granted teaching faculties must be borne out of planning disbursement to the Department for first 5 years.
